


#### **Eurovision: Network to Date**

- Mixed satellite and terrestrial network over 5 continents
- Fixed satellite Earth Stations in each country of the Union
- **50 terrestrial nodes and 4 main satellite coverages**
- Capacity tripled in 3 years
- Classical tensions have been addressed successfully:
  - Profitability vs Growth
  - ✓ Short term vs Long term
  - ✓ Whole vs parts

#### **Eurovision: Fibre Services**

- FiNE: Permanent circuits between sites and broadcaster's premises
- Video distribution Data/IP delivery with guaranteed bandwidth, dedicated channels
- Occasional Use transmissions for specific News and Sports Events:
  - ✓ US elections, End of JPII Pontificate
  - ✓ WOG 2006, Football World Cup 2006, Tennis, NHL ...
- EBU corporate applications
- Variety of formats (SD, HD....)



- ✓ 3. Maintain unmatched quality
- ✓ 4. Unify all services to Members
- ✓ 5. Risks thinking

- Earth Station design






### Aspects of the project: Operating model

- Uplink stations are "remote-controlled" from Geneva
- Geneva staff will be more sollicitated
- New staff profiles are required, such as Network administrators
- A simplified News Exchange

- Human resources






## Project schedule: Pilot phase
