


What is Elävä arkisto?

- ELÄVÄ ARKISTO (The Living Archive) is a finnish Internet service of the Finnish Broadcasting Company YLE
- This free Internet service presents a library of thousands of television and radio programmes in both Finnish and Swedish
- The service focuses on Finnish history and culture but also includes plenty of international material.
- Elävä arkisto has almost a million page displays per week.
- Growth 50 percent in 18 months


Early 2000's

- National voice- and soundgallery 2002
- Stable content with the voices of past



YLE Arkki

- Radioseries Arkiston helmiä (The pearls of the archive) 2002, from which became the content of the Internet service YLE Arkki.
 - mainly audios,
 - computers and Internet connections were mainly lowspeed, and videos should be very short
 - About 5 000 individual
 users per week less

2005, Broadband project

- Target: Bringing the ideals of the public broadcasting into the digital age
- Seven questions to think about: content of the archives, wideness of the archives, different formats, documentation, part of the broadband project, biggest challenges and obstacles
- Biggest challenges copyright

Year 2006 Grand opening

- Elävä arkisto (The Living archive)
 launched in 9.9.2006, when YLE 80 turned years
- Massive advertising campaign and a lot of publicity in finnish media
- Amount of individual weekly users was about 50 000
- Most popular content: sports (audio) and news, The talk of Hitler

AWARDS

- The State Award for Public Information presented by the Finnish Ministry of Education.
- The Most Prominent Cultural Act of the Year 2006 awarded by The Educational Fund of Finnish Radio and TV Editors.
- The Award for the Best Cultural Website in Finland 2006.



Year 2007, music, drama entertainment

- In the beginning of 2007 Elävä arkisto concluded agreements with the unions of artists, for example musicians, actors, scriptwriters, authors and dancers
- Unions appreciated Elävä arkisto for the background articles and the information of the creators of the programs

Threats

- Short contracts with the unions
- Fees arise every year
- Low budget department become expensive for the company
- More personnel needed

Possibilities

- Archive desk has many possibilities to make co-operation:
 - news and magazine programs
 - historical tv series
 - educational tv series
 - librarys, schools, hospitals, fairs
 - DVD sales, samples in Internet
- Archives are mainstream 2008

Values

- Making archive open in the Internet makes public more professional about the content of the archives
- Self-made journalist interpretation
 - Dont listen to what someone says about what the president has said but listen to the president yourself!
