### **Target audience**

This event is intended for professional cameramen / videojournalists. You do not need to have experience with DSLR cameras, but should have shooting experience with professional videocameras. Editing experience is an advantage, but not a must.

### **Equipment**

All equipment needed for this event will be provided on site. You do not have to bring your own camera (if you do, let us know). **You should however bring your own lightweight tripod suitable for a Canon 7D DSLR.** Note: if you prefer, you can bring a video-tripod with baseplate instead.

### **Costs**

We ask you for a 250 euro participation fee, which includes the use of the equipment, lunches, the Wednesday evening dinner and transport to/from the special location for the evening shoot. It does NOT include your hotel accommodation or travel to/from Geneva, which you will have to arrange and pay by yourself.

### **Confirmation**

We will explicitly confirm your participation to the event. Selection is on a first-come first-served basis.

### **Cancellation policy**

Should you need to cancel your participation for any reason, then you will still have to pay your participation fee (250 euro), unless you arrange for a replacement from your organisation or we find a replacement participant.
