 press: le film francaise, Digital Production, Berlinale Green Film Shooting Special, Medienboard Green News, FTA Bavaria Film etc.




# **GREEN FILM PRODUCTION IN GERMANY**

- Bavaria Studios went carbon neutral
- first big cinema feature film "Bully" was officially done green and received Green Shooting Card
- several TV series and more films went green
- Arri offers HighEnd LED lights for broadcast
- no financial support or incentive for Green Film Production, but recognized
- No official carbon calculator, but already some to choose from





- Different Carbon Calculators and guidelines so far
- Broadcasting Initiative on EBU level
- Producers support to stay in competition
- Legislation already partly done or planned
- ▶ US films ask for it will they demand it?


